Establishment of a Government sponsored Basic Training Centre

Girls' Sarada Mandir, Sarisha(24 Parganas).
Ref: His letter No. 1372 dated the 20th August, 1949.

The undersigned is directed to state that Government have carefully considered the proposal of the Director of Public Instruction regarding the opening of a Government sponsored Basic Training Centre for women attached to the Ramakrishna Mission Sarada Mandir at Sarisha (24 Parganas) for the establishment and maintenance of an efficient teaching service for women teachers to be trained on Basic lines for Junior Basic (Primary) Schools. They are now pleased to sanction, with effect from January, 1950, the establishment of a Government sponsored Basic Training School for women in accordance with the principles as laid down in Govt. order No. 5133-22n., dated the 20th August, 1949 with the scale of expenditure and subject to the terms and conditions as detailed below :-

- Staff (1) Principal- in the scale of Rs.100-150-170 (with a higher initial salary upto Rs.115/- according to qualifications).
- (2) 3 Lecturers in the scale of Rs.75-80-100/2-150 (with high initial salary at Rs.90/-) who should be trained and experienced graduates with special qualifications in Arts and Crafts or Physical Education.
- (3) One part time Doctor on Rs. 50/- P.M.
- (4) One Clerk & Librarian on Rs. 40-50/2-80/-
- (5) One Bearer & Mali on Rs. 30/- (fixed)
- (6) One Sweeper on Rs. 30/- (fixed)

Dearness allowance will be admissible at the rate of Rs.10/- P.M. for each full time superior staff and Rs.6/- for each servant.

Other Expenses :-

- (1) Contingencies- Rs. 100/- per annum .
- (2) Library Equipment and materials for extra- Rs.300/-per annum .
- (3) 10 stipends at the rate of Rs.20/- P.M. each - Rs.9,600/- per annum.
